Background:

The Australian Challenge game is more a fact finding set of challenges rather than a board game. The gameboard shows a distribution map of some Australian wildlife. Use this map along with the challenge cards to 'travel' around Australia finding out about the amazing wildlife portrayed on the stamps.

How to Play:

Start in any state or territory shown on the map. Place a counter on that state to record your journey around the map. Take the matching coloured challenge card. Note that there are two challenge cards for the darker green state. Complete all the challenges on the card before moving to another state or territory. There is no need to rush, maybe a challenge a day or a week. Remember it would take a long time to travel around Australia and study the wildlife! When you have completed all the states and territories (eight challenge cards), check your answers in the answers & information booklet.
